ROOM

Tow of our spacious, airy, light and Mediterranean junior suites with a relaxation zone, bathroom with shower and bath tub as well as separate toilet. Additionally you find a barrier-free handicapped accessible bathroom with shower and a variable mirror provides the perfect atmosphere for a longer time-out. They are handicapped accessible only the balcony is not barrier-free. But with a view of the Wildstrubel Massif you will certainly enjoy spending time on the panorama terrace.

PARKING

You have the possibility to park your car in our underground parking for CHF 25.- (winter) resp. CHF 20.- (summer) per night. With pleasure we will park the car for you any time if you drive it directly to the hotel entrance.

7SOURCES BEAUTY & SPA

Give your body a treat in our Spa, you will become relaxed. However, our pools and saunas only have a limited access for handicapped people. The last meters to the edge of our (swimming) pool have to be done on foot.

GUIDE DOG

An attendance animal? In our Mediterranean junior suites are dogs welcome, we will charge CHF 35.- per night resp. a flatrate of CHF 120.- from 4 nights (without food). In your room, a dog blanket and towel, as well as a water and feeding bowl will be prepared for your quadruped. Please note that we do not have any dogs harnesses. If you would rather not leave him (or her) alone in your room in the evening, we are happy to book a table for you at "Oh de Vie", our Mediterranean restaurant (at its opening times). Animals are not permitted in the "Spettacolo", our gourmet restaurant.

MOUNTAIN RESTAURANT BÜHLBERG

Lenk's most beautiful sun terrace is accessible by bus, taxi and your own car. Also here we are equipped for guests with wheelchairs with a restaurant entrance at ground level, a spacious setting and a handicapped accessible restroom.
